

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 2000

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion made by Holmes R. Shaver, seconded by David A. Couch and passed, approved minutes from September 7, 2000.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to personal property for Linda S. Huggins – Union District (1996, 1997, 1998 & 1999).

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission met with Leone Ohnoutka, from the WVU Extension Office; Blanche Rogers and Donna Hudgins, Valley Mills C.E.O.S. Cancer Committee; Jimmy Colombo, Mayor of Parkersburg; Jean Ford, Mayor of Williamstown and Michael S. Butcher, Mayor of North Hills. President Shaver read a proclamation proclaiming October 2, 2000 as West Virginia Breast Cancer Awareness Day and October, 2000 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Jamie Six, Clerk of the County Commission of Wood County presented to the County Commission of Wood County a letter listing the dates and extra hours in which the Voters Registration Office will be open to register voters prior to the General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2000. Those dates and hours are as follows:

Tuesday, October 10, 2000	4:30 P.M. - 8:00 P.M.

An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission instructed Mary Rader to get in touch with Jack Buckley and instruct him to building a 9'x11' room in the Law Library at the Judicial Building for Penny Wines. The room did not include an outside window.

The County Commission of Wood County, announced to all concerned that a vacancy will exist on the Central Boaz Public Service District. Said vacancy is due to the expiration of the term of Lawrence Hoffman III on October 1, 2000. The Commission also placed Lawrence Hoffman III in nomination to be reappointed to the Central Boaz Public District. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 64, at Page 321 and bearing the date of September 18, 2000, it was inadvertently stated that “the County Commission will pay the remaining three dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$3.00)” in reference to the PSA screening for male employees. The phrase should read, “the County Commission will pay the remaining sixteen dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$16.00)” in reference to the PSA screening for male employees. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by David A. Couch, seconded by Holmes R. Shaver and passed, did hereby ORDER that a Public Meeting be held on Thursday, November 30, 2000, at 10:00 A.M. to inspect and to accept comments from the public in regard to the ADA (Americans with Disability Act) Transition Plan for Wood County's facilities, programs and services to enable full compliance with Title II Provisions of the ADA. The meeting will be held in the County Commission Office, Room 203 of the Wood County


Courthouse. A Public Meeting Notice will be placed in both local newspapers, The Parkersburg News and The Parkersburg Sentinel. A copy of Wood County's Transition Plan is available in the Office of the County Administrator for review by the public.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, did hereby ORDER that the following Insurance and Bonding Requirements be changed from two million dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$2,000,000.00) to one million dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$1,000,000.00) – General Aggregate, Products Complete Operations Aggregate and Umbrella Coverage. The aforementioned changes are in regard to the Project Manual for Asbestos Removal and Demolition of the Sid's Building located at 300 Market Street, Parkersburg, West Virginia. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
