On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed invoices, purchase order and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved an Erroneous Assessment Application in regard to Personal Property for Franklin E. Gemmer – Walker District (2001) and Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to real property for Mansford Paul Pate – Union District (2001) and David W. & Mary I. Jeffrey – Tygart District (2001).

The County Commission met with Jack Hoffman who stated he was pleased with what happened with the Director of 911, except for the six month pay. He then stated he thinks we should charge Wirt County more for 911 services. Mr. Hoffman spoke about Coldwater Creek and Mountwood Park.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Alma Kesterson estate. After discussion, the hearing was rescheduled until August 23, 2001. Attorney Richard Hayhurst, Attorney Bob Goldenberg, Melanie Richards, Jane Richards, Frank Kesterson, Carolyn Kesterson and Carole Morrison were also present.


The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of an Abstract From The Records of the Commissioner's Orders from the West Virginia Department of Transportation,

Division of Highways, Charleston, West Virginia, in regard to the ABANDONMENT of the following described section of highway from the Local Service System in Wood County, District Three: Abandon Old Alignment of County Route 30: Beginning at the northwestern right-of-way line of present County Route 892/5, then following the alignment of Old County Route 30 in a westerly direction running to the north of and parallel to present WV 892 through Parcels B9, B8 and ending at the western boundary of Parcel B4. These parcels owned by David D. Johnson and Scott E. Brown are shown on Lubeck Tax Map 60A. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no other scheduled appointments or further business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 12:00 Noon.
