

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
MONDAY, MAY 20, 2002

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence

The County Commission, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Rick Modesitt and passed, approved minutes of March 25, 2002.

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met Ex-Officio as a Board of Canvassers, to canvass and ascertain the results of the Primary Election, held on May 14, 2002. Present was K.D. Merritt, Rick Modesitt, County Commissioners; Jamie Six, Clerk of the County Commission; Jay Day, Administrative Assistant; Melody Woollard, Barbara Johnston, Joy Jobes, Alice McCoy, Stephanie Cain, Kim Wells, Martha Devore and Ruth McBride, Deputy Clerks; Lori Lockhart, Tax Deputy; Ann Chenowith and Tessa Miller, Deputy Assessors; Angi Barry, Wood County Commission Secretary; Pam Brust, The Parkersburg News and Sentinel; and Ronnie Bibbee and Dave Sprague, Maintenance Department.

The Board of Canvassers adjourned to convene as the County Commission to hold a public hearing at 10:00 A.M., pursuant to an ORDER entered on the eighteenth day of April, 2002, setting this matter for hearing in accordance with Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 3(h) of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, in regard to a PETITION received from George C. White. It appearing to the County Commission of Wood County that the Notice of the time and date of said Public Hearing was published as a Class I Legal Advertisement in both The

Parkersburg News and The Parkersburg Sentinel, newspapers published regularly in Wood County, West Virginia, with said publication appearing on April 26, 2002, of which appears by an Affidavit of Publication, which said Affidavit is hereby ORDERED filed. The only abutting property owner, the I-77 U.S. Route 50 Ramada Inn had been notified of the Public Hearing and served by certified mail by the Petitioner, George C. White, with notice of service being presented at the Public Hearing by the said George C. White, which is hereby ORDERED to be filed. After reviewing the documentation presented, the County Commission of Wood County does hereby find the Petitioner George C. White has satisfied the requirement set forth in the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended. The aforementioned PETITION requests the closing of a portion of Victory Street between Altman Drive and Moore Drive and running approximately two hundred fifty-eight (258) feet in length along the property of the said George C. White and the I-77 U.S. Route 50 Ramada Inn. The said I-77 U.S. Route 50 Ramada Inn has no objection to the closing of a section of the said Victory Street. No objections were heard at the aforementioned Public Hearing. The aforementioned Victory Street is thirty (30) feet in width, is located in Parkersburg Taxing District, Tax Map 221, in what is known as Hill Top Addition recorded in Plat Book 7, Page 6. NOW, THEREFORE, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Rick Modesitt and passed, does hereby ORDER that the aforementioned section of Victory Street located in Parkersburg Taxing District be CLOSED since no use and right of any persons, firms or corporation in the aforementioned Victory Street will be impaired or lost by the closing and vacating. The County Commission further ORDERS that a copy of the ORDER be certified by the Clerk of the County Commission for entry in the Office of the County Clerk of the County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia, pursuant to Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 3(h) of the Code of West

Virginia of 1931, as amended, and that the interests of the County of Wood in such Victory Street, by quit-claim deeds, be the responsibility of such abutting property owners, George C. White and the I-77 U. S. Route 50 Ramada Inn. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Rick Modesitt and passed, placed Roger Sheppard of WTAP-TV in nomination for reappointment to the 911 Advisory Board. This nomination is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 51, at Page 433 bearing the date of April 1, 1991 and deals with the procedure policy for appointments to boards and authorities. The new term will expire April 30, 2005. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a check from the State of West Virginia in the amount of five thousand eighty-eight dollars and sixty-six cents (\$5,088.66) of which the amount of two thousand two hundred thirty-one dollars and seventeen cents (\$2,231.17) represents reimbursement to Wood County for expenses incurred during the month of February, 2002, in regard to the Enforcing the Underage Drinking Laws Grant Number 01-UD-55. Receipt of the aforementioned check is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 65, at Page 152 and bearing the date of March 11, 2002, at which time the Request for Reimbursement was EXECUTED by Robert K. Tebay, in his official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission. Documentation pertaining to the STOP Violence Against Women Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, at 11:00 o'clock A.M., opened the sealed bid received from the Environmental Design Group, 1107 Ninth Street, Vienna, WV, for Engineering Services in regard to the Fort Boreman Park. Receipt of the sealed bid is pursuant

to an ORDER appearing in Order Book 65, at Page 199 and bearing the date of April 29, 2002, at which time the County Commission of Wood County ORDERED that the request for proposals be let; and further pursuant to a Legal Notice appearing in both The Parkersburg News and the Parkersburg Sentinel on May 6, 2002 and on May 13, 2002. The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Rick Modesitt and passed, did hereby take the proposal submitted by the Environmental Design Group under advisement. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Terry L. Brown, Director of Wood County Emergency Services/E-9-1-1, presented to the County Commission of Wood County, a New Road Name Request Form from Joseph Robert Anderson and Jennifer M. Anderson to name the road to their residence. The said Request does not interfere with the scheduled readdressing and mapping for the E-9-1-1 Master Street Addressing Guide. Joseph Robert Anderson and Jennifer M. Anderson, along with Gary Oates and Connie Oates requested the road be named HUMMINGBIRD LANE. The road to be known as HUMMINGBIRD LANE provides access to the aforementioned residences as stated in the Andersons' Request Form. The road to be known as HUMMINGBIRD LANE is located 9/10 of a mile North on Route 2 past the intersection of Route 31 which is the second drive on the right past Coopers Ridge Road in Union Taxing District, Tax Map 90, Parcel Number A-1B. The request by Joseph Robert Anderson and Jennifer M. Anderson is in accordance with Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, which deals, in part, with the County Commission naming or renaming thereof of roads, ways, streets, avenues, drives and the like to assure uniform, nonduplicative conversion of all rural routes to city-type addressing on a permanent basis. The County Commission does hereby find that the said request, made in writing, by Joseph Robert Anderson and Jennifer M. Anderson, and the approval from the Wood

County Emergency Services/E-9-1-1, is in proper form and is hereby ORDERED to be filed. NOW, THEREFORE, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Rick Modesitt and passed, does hereby ORDER that the aforementioned road be named HUMMINGBIRD LANE. The County Commission does further ORDER that a copy of the ORDER, along with the New Road Name Request Form, be certified by the Clerk of the County Commission for entry in the Office of the Clerk of the County Commission of Wood County. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 11:15 A.M., the County Commission adjourned to meet as the Board of Canvassers and worked through their lunch.

At 1:30 P.M., the Board of Canvassers adjourned to meet as the County Commission to meet with Brett Pickens, Deputy and Charlie Johnson, Chief Deputy, to discuss a Click It or Ticket Proclamation. The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Rick Modesitt and passed, did hereby EXECUTE a PROCLAMATION in which it is designated that the months of May, July, August and September, 2002 be proclaimed as the West Virginia CLICK IT OR TICKET CHALLENGE MONTHS. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, placed Gary Deem, City of Vienna; S.F. Greiner, Wood County Sheriff; Charles Meyers, Wood County Firefighters Association; and John Knapp, City of Parkersburg, in nomination for reappointment to the 911 Advisory Board. Said nominations are pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 51, at Page 433 and bearing the date of April 1, 1991, dealing with the procedure policy for appointments to Boards and Authorities. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Rick Modesitt and passed, did hereby ORDER that the compensation for Ballot Commissioners be increased from twenty-five dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$25.00) for each day to fifty dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$50.00) for each day he or she serves as Ballot Commissioner, not to receive allowance for more than ten (10) days' service for any one primary, general or special election. Such action is pursuant to a letter from Carole Jones, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Wood County, and is further pursuant to Chapter 3, Article 1, Section 44 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended and becomes effective with the Primary Election held on May 14, 2002. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of the Approval of the Request for Revision to Approved Budget from the West Virginia State Auditor, Chief Inspector Division, Charleston West Virginia, in regard to Revision No. 11 in the General County Fund budget for the fiscal year 2001/2002. Receipt of said Approval is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 65, at Page 205 and bearing the date of May 6, 2002, at which time the Request for Revision was signed by Robert K. Tebay, President of the Wood County Commission. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a check from the State of West Virginia in the amount of five thousand eighty-eight dollars and sixty-six cents (\$5,088.66) of which the amount of two thousand eight hundred fifty-seven dollars and forty-nine cents (\$2,857.49) represents reimbursement to Wood County for expenses incurred during the month of March, 2002 in regard to the STOP Violence Against Women Grant Number 00-VAW-028. Receipt of the aforementioned check is pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 65, at Page 193 and bearing the date of April 22, 2002, at which time the Request for Reimbursement

was EXECUTED BY Robert K. Tebay, in his official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission. Documentation pertaining to the STOP Violence Against Women Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

At 2:00 P.M., the County Commission adjourned and met as the Board of Canvassers.

The ballots, tally sheets and certification of the various voting places were placed before the Board of Canvassers at this time. It appearing to this Board of Canvassers that the several challenged ballots, in the various precincts, were properly made, the challenges either over-ruled or sustained, and other changes in the tabulation of voters were altered, the canvass is complete, as required by law, and the Board, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Rick Modesitt and passed, do hereby declare the election results.

The five precincts that were drawn to hand count were Numbers 88, 23, 15, 40 and 29. They were found to be within the 1% error margin allowed.

The Board, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Rick Modesitt, and passed, adjourned at 5:00 P.M. and will meet again on Thursday, May 23, 2002, to certify the results of said election. A copy of the results of this Primary Election is attached to this Order and shall be made a part thereof.
