On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met Ex-Officio as a Board of Canvassers, to canvass and ascertain the results of the General Election, held on November 5, 2002. Present were Robert K. Tebay and Rick Modesitt, County Commissioners; Jamie Six, Clerk of the County Commission; Jay Day, Administrative Assistant; Melody Woollard, Barbara Johnston, Leslie Dipasquale, Liz Adkins and Kim Wells, Deputy Clerks; Ralph Gentz, Deputy Assessor; Angi Barry, Wood County Commission Secretary; Jeff Saultan, The Parkersburg News and Sentinel; Curtis Sams and Dave Sprague, Maintenance Department; Dorothy Turner, Betty Carpenter, Darlene Thorn and Betty Swisher, temporary part-time Deputy Clerks and Judy Lewis, WVU Extension Office. The ballots, tally sheets and certification of the various voting places were placed before the Board of Canvassers at 9:45 A.M.


In accordance with Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28 of the West Virginia Code, as amended, Precincts 37C, 89, 45A, 71 and 67A were chosen at random to be counted manually during the Canvass of the General Election. The Precincts were found to be free from error within the one percent (1%) difference of the tabulation count, held on election night, November 5, 2002 and meets all requirements as required by the West Virginia Code. The County Commission of Wood County, sitting ex-officio as a Board of Canvassers, upon a motion made by Rick Modesitt, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, do hereby CERTIFY that the five percent (5%) hand count of the General Election meets the requirements of less than one percent


(1%) difference of the tabulator count. Precinct Number 71 was counted by Betty Carpenter and Darlene Thorn and completed at 10:55 A.M.; Precinct Number 89 was counted by Barbara Johnston and Dorothy Turner and completed at 11:16 AM.; Precinct Number 67A was counted by Kim Wells and Judy Lewis and completed at 11:35 A.M.; Precinct Number 37C was counted by Leslie DiPasquale and Ralph Gentz and completed at 11:45 A.M.; and Precinct Number 45A was counted by Liz Adkins and Betty Swisher and completed at 11:46 A.M. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

It appearing to this Board of Canvassers that the several challenged ballots, in the various precincts, were properly made, the challenges either over-ruled or sustained, and other changes in the tabulation of voters were altered, the canvass is complete, as required by law, and the Board, upon a motion made by Rick Modesitt, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, do hereby declare the election results. The Board adjourned at 12:33 P.M. and will meet again on Wednesday, November 27, 2002, to certify the results of said election.
