

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
THURSDAY, AUGUST 7, 2003

At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission went to Ohio Valley College to speak at the State Fire Department Convention.

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by Rick Modesitt, approved minutes from July 3, 2003, July 7, 2003 and July 10, 2003.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to personal property for Federal Express Corp. – Williams District (2003); Eric W. Thompson – Parkersburg City District (2003); William Malloy – Parkersburg City District (2003); Kerri Griffith – Williamstown District (2003); Brian K. Mitchell – Union District (2003); Larry B. Westfall – Parkersburg City District (2002 & 2003); John R. Coe – Parkersburg City District (2003); Janet B. Youell – Parkersburg City District (2002); Leo W. Wilson – Steele District (2003); Ivan O. The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to real property for Tina M. Little – Parkersburg City District (2003); Vickie L. Piper – Parkersburg City District (2003); Deborah McKibben – Clay District (2003); Eugene Mellinger – Union District (2003); Marian L. Yoke Martin – Parkersburg City District (2003); M C Development Co. Inc. – Tygart District (2003); Carol J. Wildman - Harris District (2003); Robert E. Wildman – Harris District (2003); Deloris F. Davis – Parkersburg City District (2003; Harold Adkins – Parkersburg City District (2003); Geneva S. Stables – Vienna District (two for 2002) and Earlene L. Donaway – Parkersburg City District (2002).

At 11:00 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Alma Kesterson estate. Attorney Richard Hayhurst and Attorney Dave Underwood were present along with Janet McCauley, Julia Hoffman and Carole Morrison. After discussion, the County Commission, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by Rick Modesitt (K.D. Merritt abstained) continued this hearing to September 18, 2003 at 10:30 A.M.

At 11:20 A.M., the County Commission, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Rick Modesitt (Robert K. Tebay, recused himself) went into Executive Session upon authority granted in West Virginia Code, Chapter 6, Article 9A, Section 4, No. 9 and No. 12. Ginny Conley, Prosecuting Attorney was present. They adjourned said Executive Session at 12:06 P.M.

At 12:10 P.M., the County Commission met with Brian Honey from Salter and Associates to discuss the design and content of the county's website. Carole Jones, Circuit Clerk and Julie Knight, Deputy Circuit Clerk, were present. Mr. Honey showed the Commission the home page for the County's website and explained how it will work. The

County Commission made some suggestions as far as putting on the new 911 addressing issue; family law master, magistrate court, etc. Mr. Honey will still be meeting with elected officials next week.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, ORDERED that Erroneous Assessment Application No. 1115 pertaining to personal property, found in Order Book 65, at Page 467 and bearing the date of March 31, 2003, be voided due to the fact it is uncollectible. Said Erroneous Assessment Application is in the name of Jeff Orosco and is for property located in Parkersburg District.


Terry L. Brown, Director of Wood County Emergency Services/E-9-1-1, presented to the County Commission of Wood County, a New Road Name Request Form from John Huffman to rename the road now known as Berkley Drive. Said Request does not interfere with the scheduled readdressing and mapping for the E-9-1-1 Master Street Addressing Guide. John J. Huffman and Vicky W. Huffman, request the road, which is now known as Berkley Drive be named RIVERSIDE DRIVE. The road to be known as RIVERSIDE DRIVE provides access to a rental house and a trailer as stated in Mr. Huffman's Request Form. The road to be known as RIVERSIDE DRIVE is located 9/10 mile out Nicolette Road, turn right just past Bob's Bicycle Shop in Clay Taxing District, Tax Map 290, Parcel Number 120. The request by John Huffman is in accordance with Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, which deals, in part, with the County Commission naming or renaming thereof of roads, ways, streets, avenues, drives and the like to assure uniform, nonduplicative conversion of all rural routes to city-type addressing on a permanent basis. The County Commission does hereby find that the said request, made in writing, by John Huffman, and the approval from the Wood County Emergency Services/E-9-1-1, is in proper form and is

hereby ORDERED to be filed. NOW, THEREFORE, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by Rick Modesitt, does hereby ORDER that the aforementioned road be named RIVERSIDE DRIVE. The County Commission does further ORDER that a copy of the ORDER, along with the New Road Name Request Form, be certified by the Clerk of the County Commission for entry in the Office of the Clerk of the County Commission. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 12:50 P.M.



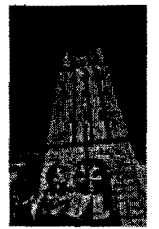
