IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD  
MONDAY, JANUARY 13, 2003

On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to personal property for Brooks R. Swesey – Parkersburg City District (2002); Rebecca D. Wilson – Vienna District (2002); Wilbur Richards – Union District (2001 & 2002); and for Ronald L. Brown – Slate District (2001).

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to real property for Good Samaritan Clinic, Inc. – Parkersburg City District (1999, 2000, 2001 & 2002); Huntington National Bank – Parkersburg City (1998); John Longfellow – Clay District (2002); and for Douglas C. Griener – Lubeck District (2002).

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Steve Bayer and Gary Hamilton from the Mid-Ohio Valley Health Department to give an update on the West Nile Virus Program, they also discussed a conference that they will be attending, etc.

At 1:00 P.M., the County Commission distributed lottery checks. Gary Wolfe, Dave Ashley, Sam Winans, Jim Beckner and Bill Merriman were present.

At 1:45 P.M., the County Commission met with Jamie Six, County Clerk and Melody Woollard, Deputy Clerk to discuss a proposal for precinct consolidation. A copy of handouts is attached to these minutes. This will be further discussed on Thursday, January 16, 2003.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by Rick Modesitt and made unanimous by K.D. Merritt, did hereby EXECUTE a Corporate Credit Card Line of Credit Application from WesBanco Bank, Inc., 415 Market Street, Parkersburg, West Virginia. The credit card limit is in the amount of three thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$3,000.00) and will be used by the County Commission for hotel/motel reservations for County business, for some computer purchases and for any purchase(s), approved by the County Commission of Wood County, that require a credit card.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, ORDERED that Erroneous Assessment Application No. 952 pertaining to personal property, found in Order Book 65, at Page 371 and bearing the date of December 5, 2002, be voided due to the fact that the wrong property was exonerated. Said Erroneous Assessment Application is in the name of Nancy Baughman and is for property located in Parkersburg District. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, ORDERED that Erroneous Assessment Application No. 951 pertaining to personal property, found in Order Book 65, at Page 371 and bearing the date of December 5, 2002, be voided due to the fact that the wrong property was exonerated. Said Erroneous Assessment Application is in the name of Nancy Baughman and is for property located in Parkersburg District. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of Grant Adjustment Notice Number One (1) from the Division of Criminal Justice Services, Charleston, West Virginia, in regard to the STOP Violence Against Women Grant Number 01-VAW-010. The aforementioned Grant Adjustment Notice changes the Authorized Official from Robert K.

Tebay to Rick Modesitt effective January 1, 2003. Documentation pertaining to the STOP Violence Against Women Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE Rick Modesitt, in his official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to EXECUTE the Performance Schedule; the Certification of Financial Management System Compliance with the "Common Rule", 24CFR85, Requirements; the Request for Approval of Evidentiary Materials and Releases of Funds; and the Application/Recipient Disclosure/Update Report in regard to the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant in the amount of six hundred thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$600,000.00). The aforementioned funding will be utilized in the assistance in the opening of a regional telecommunications center by Sequelle Communications Alliance, Inc. Documentation in regard to the aforementioned Small Cities Community Development Block Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, placed Kevin Campbell, Gary Deem, Danny Goodwin, Doug Hess, Larry Stephens and Dwane Weekley in nomination for reappointment to the Wood County Local Emergency Planning Committee. Said vacancies are due to the fact that said members terms expired on December 31, 2002 and is further pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 51, at Page 433 and bearing the date of April 1, 1991, dealing with the procedure policy for appointments to Board and Authorities. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a check in the amount of ten thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$10,000.00) from the United States Treasury in regard to the Community Gun Violence Prosecution Grant Number 2002-GP-CX-0127. Receipt of the aforementioned check is pursuant to an ORDER appearing in Order Book 65, at Page 392 and bearing the date of January 6, 2003, at which time the Request was made by a phone activated paperless request system. Documentation pertaining to the Community Gun Violence Prosecution Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of Grant Adjustment Notice Number One (1) from the Division of Criminal Justice Services, Charleston, West Virginia, in regard to the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant Number 01-VA-047. The aforementioned Grant Adjustment Notice changes the Authorized Official from Robert K. Tebay to Rick Modesitt effective January 1, 2003. Documentation pertaining to the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by K.D. Merritt, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, did hereby AWARD the bid for the purchase and installation of carpet throughout the Wood County Judicial Building and a portion of the Wood County Courthouse to Family Carpet One, P.O. Box 161, Parkersburg, West Virginia. The AWARDING of such bid is pursuant to an ORDER appearing in Order Book 65, at Page 385 and bearing the date of December 30, 2002, at which time the County Commission of Wood County opened the lone bid and took such bid under advisement. The bid was in the amount of eighty-one thousand six hundred thirty-eight dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$81,638.00).






Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at approximately 4:00 P.M.
