IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD  
THURSDAY, MARCH 30, 2006

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence. Upon a motion made by Bob Tebay, seconded by Rick Modesitt and made unanimous by Gary D. Deem, the County Commission approved minutes of February 3, 2006 and February 8, 2006.

At 10:25 A.M., Joellen Blair met with the County Commission to request a donation to the Progressive Farmer Day Camp. The County Commission was unable to donate any funds because of a hold on all outside expenditures; all expenditures are deferred till July 1, 2006.

At 10:30 A.M., Dan Marshall met with the County Commission to discuss the attorney fees for Bowles Rice Law Firm. After discussion the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by Gary D. Deem, opposed by Rick Modesitt and passed, did hereby approve payment of a bill presented to the County Commission by Bowles – Rice Law Firm, Charleston, West Virginia. Said bill was in the amount of seven thousand, two hundred thirty dollars and eighty-four cents (\$7,230.84). The bill was for services rendered and expenses incurred as counsel to the Wood County Building Commission. An order was prepared.

At 11:00 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County held a public auction for the purpose of selling used vehicles, property and miscellaneous items. This auction was held

pursuant to a legal Notice being published in both The Parkersburg News and The Parkersburg Sentinel on March 3, 2006 and March 10, 2006. The auction was held at the Wood County Sheriff's Department/Maintenance building with the auctioneer being Rocky Peck. The amount of twenty four thousand seven hundred eighty five dollars and fifty cents (\$24,786.50) was taken in for the vehicles and miscellaneous items. The property was sold for twenty-eight thousand dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$28,000.00) and will be placed in the General County Fund budget. Documentation pertaining to said auction is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An order was prepared.


At 12:00 P.M., the County Commission toured the Holding Center facility for office assignments.




With no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned.
