At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Rick Modesitt, seconded by Gary D. Deem and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE the donation of five (5) Wood County Bicentennial books to the Jackson Junior High School Music Department. An order was prepared.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Rick Modesitt, seconded by Gary D. Deem and passed, did hereby AUTHORIZE the donation of the following Wood County Bicentennial items to the Julia-Ann Historical District: one (1) gold coin, two (2) books and two (2) atlases. An order was prepared.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Rick Modesitt, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by Gary D. Deem, NOMINATED Steve Simonton and Lois Francisco for appointment to the Wood County Local Emergency Planning Commission. Said nominations are pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 51, at Page 433 and bearing the date of April 1, 1991, dealing with the procedure policy for appointments to Boards and Authorities. The terms will expire on December 31, 2008. An order was prepared.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Rick Modesitt, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by Gary D. Deem reappointed the following members to the Wood County Local Emergency Planning Committee: Randy Lowe, Steve Stephens, Danny Goodwin, Kenny Harris, Doug Hess, Rebecca Adams, Kevin Campbell, Rob Talkington and Larry Stephens. Said reappointments are pursuant to an Order appearing in Order Book 51, at Page 433 and bearing the date of April 1, 1991, dealing with the procedure policy for appointments to Boards and Authorities. The new terms will expire December 31, 2008. An order was prepared.

The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a New Road Name Request Form from Dianna D. Davis, to change the name of the current road from Handle Road to DAVIS LANE. The said Request does not interfere with the scheduled readdressing and mapping for the E-9-1-1 Master Street Addressing Guide. The road to be known as DAVIS LANE is located 6/10 mile up Meadville Road and is in Clay Taxing District, Tax Map 250, Parcel H5. The request by Dianna D. Davis is in accordance with Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, which deals, in part, with the County Commission naming or renaming thereof of roads, ways, streets, avenues, drives and the like to assure uniform, nonduplicative conversion of all rural routes to city-type addressing on a permanent basis. The County Commission does hereby find that the said request, made in writing, by Dianna D. Davis, and the approval from the Wood County E-9-1-1, is in proper form and is hereby ORDERED to be filed. NOW, THEREFORE, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by Gary D. Deem and made unanimous by Rick Modesitt, does hereby ORDER that the aforementioned road be named DAVIS LANE. The County Commission does further ORDER that a copy of the ORDER that


was prepared, along with the New Road Name Request Form, be certified by the Clerk of the County Commission for entry in the Office of the Clerk of the County Commission.

Lt. Brian Rader met with the County Commission to discuss the placement of returned furniture. It was stated to Lt Rader by the Commission to place the furniture in storage room located in the back of the Magistrate Court building.


With no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned.


