On this date, the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Ellen M. Prince estate. Attorney Bob Black asked that the Administratrix, Sandra Wingrove be removed. After discussion, the County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, removed Sandra Wingrove and appointed L. Gregory Prince as Administrator d.b.n with a bond of \$100.00. Information regarding this estate is on file in the Probate Office.

At 11:00 A.M., the County commission presented a resolution to the Williamstown High School Class A State Championship Football Team.
