TUESDAY, MAY 20, 2008

At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session, sitting Ex-Officio as a Board of Canvassers. Said session is pursuant to Chapter 3, Article 7, Section 17 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and is for the purpose of canvassing and ascertaining the results of the Primary Election held on May 13, 2008.

Those participating in the canvass were Rick Modesitt, David Blair Couch and Robert K. Tebay, Commissioners; Jamie Six, Clerk of Wood County; Melody Woollard, Barbara Johnston, Leslie Dotson, Diana Garrett and Elizabeth Beary from the County Clerk's Office; Ronnie Bibbee, Wood County Maintenance; Angi Helmick, Wood County Commission Office; Darlene Thorn, Dorothy Turner, Betty Carpenter and Patty Jo Thompson, Travis Woollard, Megan Adkins, Kay Williams, Barbara O'Bryon, Beverly Lockhart, Susan Knopp, Lara Rush, Peggy Mullenix and April Fry, part-time workers.

Mr. Six spoke with poll workers and the Commissioners due to questions about Precinct 67A. Precinct 67A had ballots that were not coded correctly on Election Day. Prosecuting Attorney Ginny Conley was contacted. She and Mr. Six called the WV Secretary of State's Office for their opinion. The County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Rick Modesitt and made unanimous by Robert K. Tebay, Ordered that the provisionals for Precinct 67A be counted to err on the side of the voter.

The County Commission met with a voter who wanted to vote again. After talking with said voter, the County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Rick Modesitt and made unanimous by Robert K. Tebay, Ordered that said voter not be permitted to vote again.


The County Commission had seven absentee ballots by mail. The County Commission, upon a motion made by Rick Modesitt, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by David Blair County, Ordered the absentee ballots be allowed. Early voting provisions were also completed at this time.

The County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Rick Modesitt and made unanimous by Robert K. Tebay, announced to all concerned that they will be sitting, Ex-Officio as a Board of Canvassers on Wednesday, May 21, 2008 at 9:00 A.M. for the purpose of continuing the canvassing and ascertaining the results of the Primary Election held on May 13, 2008.

The County Commission, upon a motion made by Rick Modesitt, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and passed, adjourned at 4:50 P.M.


