IN RE: MINUTES OF MEETING HELD  
WEDNESDAY, MAY 21, 2008

At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission met, sitting Ex-Officio as a Board of Canvassers. Said session is pursuant to Chapter 3, Article 7, Section 17 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and is for the purpose of canvassing and ascertaining the results of the Primary Election held on May 13, 2008.

Those participating in the canvass were Rick Modesitt, David Blair Couch and Robert K. Tebay, Commissioners; Jamie Six, Clerk of Wood County; Melody Woollard, Barbara Johnston, Leslie Dotson, Diana Garrett and Elizabeth Beary from the County Clerk's Office; Ronnie Bibbee, Wood County Maintenance; Angi Helmick, Wood County Commission Office; Darlene Thorn, Dorothy Turner, Betty Carpenter and Patty Jo Thompson, Travis Woollard, Megan Adkins, Kay Williams, Barbara O'Bryon, Beverly Lockhart, Susan Knopp, Lara Rush, Peggy Mullenix and April Fry, part-time workers.


In accordance with Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28 of the West Virginia Code, as amended, Precincts 1, 32, 37 and 56A were chosen at random to be counted manually during the Canvass of the Primary Election. The Precincts were found to be free from error within the one percent (1%) difference of the tabulation count, held on election night, May 13, 2008 and meets all requirements as required by the West Virginia Code. The County Commission of Wood County, sitting ex-officio as a Board of Canvassers, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by Rick Modesitt, do hereby CERTIFY that the hand count

of the Primary Election meets the requirements of less than one percent (1%) difference of the tabulator count. Precinct 56A was counted by Kay Williams, Patty Jo Thomspson and Darlene Thorn and was completed on May 21, 2008 at 9:30 A.M.; Precinct 37 was counted by Barbara O'Bryon, Beverly Lockhart, Dorothy Turner and Leslie Dotson and was completed on May 21, 2008 at 10:20 A.M.; Precinct 32 was counted by Elizabeth Beary, Diana Garrett, Megan Adkins, Travis Woollard and was completed on May 21, 2008 at 12:30 P.M.; Precinct 1 was counted by Susan Knopp, Lara Rush, Peggy Mullenix and April Fry and was completed on May 21, 2008 at 1:07 P.M.

At 1:10 P.M., the County Commission, ballots, tally sheets and certification of the various places were placed before the Board of Canvassers. It appearing to this board of Canvassers that the several challenged ballots (provisionals), in the various precincts, were property made, the challenges either over-ruled or sustained, and other changes in the tabulation of voters were altered, the canvass is complete, as required by law, and the Board, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by Rick Modesitt, do hereby DECLARE the election results and ORDERED that a \$300.00 bond be required of any person who wishes to have a recount. Upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by Rick Modesitt and passed, did hereby ORDER that the Board of Canvassers do now adjourn until 1:30 P.M. on Friday, May 23, 2008 when they will meet in Special Session to CERTIFY the Primary Election results. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.


