In addition to the Request for Reimbursement the Time Sheets for employees of the Wood County Day Report Center, the Monthly Project Director's Report and the Project Financial Reports are being submitted to the Criminal Justice Services, Charleston, West Virginia. Documentation pertaining to the Community Corrections Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Wayne Dunn, seconded by David Blair Couch and made unanimous by Rick Modesitt, did hereby AUTHORIZE Rick Modesitt, in his official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, to EXECUTE the Request for Payment and the Certification of Grant Completion in regard to the Governor's Community Partnership Grant Program funding in the amount of twelve thousand nine hundred four dollars and thirty-one cents (\$12,904.31) allocated to the United Way Alliance of Mid-Ohio Valley. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a check from the State of West Virginia in the amount of three thousand eight hundred ninety-three dollars and six cents (\$3,893.06) which represents reimbursement to Wood County for expenses incurred during the month of October, 2008, in regard to the Strategic Prevention Framework State Incentive Grant Number 09-SIG-17. Receipt of the aforementioned check is pursuant to an ORDER appearing in Order Book 68, at Page 421 and bearing the date of November 17, 2008 at which time Robert K. Tebay, in his official capacity as President and on behalf of the County Commission, was AUTHORIZED to EXECUTE the Request for Reimbursement. Documentation pertaining

to the Strategic Prevention Framework State Incentive Grant is on file in the Office of the County Administrator. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.
