On this date, the County Commission met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to real property for Randy J. & Stephani Williams – Parkersburg District (two for 2008).

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to personal property for Alonzo Gibson – Parkersburg City District (2006); Bosley Rental & Supply Inc. – Parkersburg City District (2007 and 2008); Kevin A. Mahaffey – Lubeck District (2008); Brian Devan – Clay District (2008); Jeffrey George – Parkersburg City District (2007); Kenneth R. Guinn – Williams District (2008); and Linda Schofield – Slate District (2008).

At 9:45 A.M., the County Commission met with Carol Roush from the West Virginia Department of Highways Salvage Yard Inspection Division and addressed the County Commission in response to a call received from Commissioner Dunn. Ms. Roush stated the yard he questioned is located within the City limits and the City is responsible for that yard.

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Jeff Sandy, Sheriff; Dennie Huggins, Chief Tax Deputy; Ron Catlett, Jail Administrator; Dave Joy, Home Confinement; and T.R. Smith, Sheriff's Department to discuss their budget.


The County Commission of Wood County was in receipt of a New Road Name Request Form from Connie Lewis, to name the road to her residence COLT RIDGE DRIVE. The said Request does not interfere with the scheduled readdressing and mapping for the E-9-1-1 Master Street Addressing Guide. The road to be known as COLT RIDGE DRIVE is located 3.8 MILE OUT Loomis ridge on the left, in Union District, Tax Map 600, Parcel F6. The request by Connie Lewis is in accordance with Chapter 7, Article 1, Section 3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, which deals, in part, with the County Commission naming or renaming thereof of roads, ways, streets, avenues, drives and the like to assure uniform, nonduplicative conversion of all rural routes to city-type addressing on a permanent basis. The County Commission does hereby find that the said request, made in writing, by Connie Lewis, and the approval from the Wood County E-9-1-1, is in proper form and is hereby ORDERED to be filed. NOW, THEREFORE, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Wayne Dunn, seconded by Rick Modesitt and made unanimous by David Blair Couch and passed, does hereby ORDER that the aforementioned road be named COLT RIDGE DRIVE. The County Commission does further ORDER that a copy of this ORDER, along with the New Road Name Request Form, be certified by the Clerk of the County Commission for entry in the Office of the Clerk of the County Commission. An Order was prepared regarding this matter.

Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned.


