

## OFFICIAL BALLOT THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE COUNTY OF WOOD PRIMARY ELECTION HELD TUESDAY, MAY 10, 2022

Shall The Board of Education of the County of Wood incur debt and issue Bonds, in one or more series, in the amount of not more than SIXTY MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,850,000), with maturities on such Bonds to run not more than fifteen and three-quarter (15 3/4) years from the date of such Bonds, with interest not exceeding the rate of four and one-half percent (4.50%) per annum, payable semi-annually, for the purpose of making the following improvements in the Wood County School District (Estimated Costs to include both the Bond proceeds and proceeds of grants, if any, received from the School Building Authority of West Virginia, and amounts from other sources, as shown below) to provide adequate, safe and convenient educational facilities for the School District, and levy taxes sufficient to pay the interest on and the principal of such Bonds.
