SPECIAL LEVY ELECTION

Special election to authorize the renewal of existing additional levies for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2027, and July 1, 2028, for the purpose of providing for the continued operation of the mass transit (bus) system in the cities of Parkersburg and Vienna, West Virginia, according to the Order of the Council of the City of Parkersburg adopted on the 27th day of January, 2026.
