

## A call for candidates for Town Council and Town Officers:

Town election will be held during the West Virginia General Election on November 5<sup>th</sup>.

Any Town resident who wishes to serve on Council or as Mayor or Recorder is encouraged to make the commitment to donate their time and energy.

Any person who is eligible to hold an office shall file with the Recorder of the town a certificate declaring himself a candidate for the nomination for such office; which certificate shall be in form or effect as follows:

I, Diana M. Wilson, hereby certify that I am a candidate for the nomination for the office of town council and desire my name printed on the official ballot to be voted at the election to be held on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November; that I am a legally qualified voter of the county of Wood, State of West Virginia; that my residence is number 102 of Tanglewood Pl street in the town of North Hills in Wood county in said State; that I am eligible to hold the said office; that I am a candidate for said office in good faith.
